The Australian Veterans' Children Assistance Trust (AVCAT) is a national independent charity. AVCAT helps the children and grandchildren of Australian ex-service men and women to a better future by providing tertiary education scholarships. Through the generous support of the Australian Government Department of Veterans' Affairs, ex-service organisations and private donors, AVCAT offers up to 110 new scholarships each year for students enrolled at Australian universities, TAFEs and registered training organisations.

To be eligible to apply, students must meet the following criteria:

- A child, step-child, foster child, or grandchild of an Australian veteran
- An Australian citizen or permanent resident
- Enrolled, or planning to enrol for 2018, in a full-time course at an Australian university, TAFE or registered training organisation
- Receiving, or eligible to receive, Centrelink Youth Allowance or an equivalent means-tested educational payment
